The Department of State Health Services (DSHS) and CORPUS CHRISTI-NUECES COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT (COUNTY) (Contractor) agree to amend the Program Attachment # 002A (Program Attachment) to Contract # 2013-041393 (Contract) in accordance with this Amendment No. 002B : STD - HIV, effective 05/01/2013 .

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The purpose of this Amendment is to add additional funds to cover the increased costs associated with syphilis and/or HIV morbidity and to reallocate funds to reflect actual expenditures.

Therefore, DSHS and Contractor agree as follows:

The Program Attachment number is revised as follows:

Section I. STATEMENT OF WORK, is revised to add the following:

Contractor shall identify zip codes within its service area which show increased syphilis and/or HIV morbidity, and shall then conduct targeted HIV and Syphilis testing events associated with case investigations to identify persons who may be at increased risk for HIV/STD; persons who test positive will be referred for treatment and referrals to medical care. These events must be conducted within 90 days of the effective date of this May 2013 amendment.

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SECTION II. PERFORMANCE MEASURES, STD PROGRAM OBJECTIVES, is revised to include the following:

Contractor shall diligently follow the requirements for each of the STD Program objectives, as excerpted below. If the data submitted by Contractor (or otherwise obtained by DSHS) indicates that Contractor's performance does not meet the standards stated in one (1) or more of the objectives, DSHS may (at its sole discretion) require additional measures be taken by Contractor to improve performance. Contractor must implement these measures according to a timetable mandated by DSHS. Contractor shall ensure funds are used to address increases in syphilis and/or HIV morbidity; specifically, funds are provided to support HIV/STD testing and public health follow up activities to ensure persons infected or at increased risk are appropriately tested, treated and referred for medical care. The contractor will report the number of case-related screening events performed from May 1-August 31, 2013, including the number of persons tested at each event and the number of new positives identified at each event. This report of case related screening events shall be reported in the semi-annual narrative under "IV. Areas of Special Emphasis".

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Categorical Budget is revised as attached.

All other terms and conditions not hereby amended are to remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the terms of this contract and the terms of this Amendment, this Amendment shall control.
