CREATION & AUTHORITY:

This board is authorized by Senate Bill No. 1426, 71st Legislature, Regular Session 1989 by Mental Health Code, 5547.203.

Fourth Thursday of every month at 5:00 p.m., 3733 S. Port Street, C.C., TX.

TERMS: Two year terms with five board positions expiring in April of even-numbered years and four board positions expiring in April of odd-numbered years.
