

## NUECES COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #6

### DUTIES:

The protection of life and property from fire and for the conservation of natural and human resources. Control and administer the property, debts, and assets of the district.

### COMPOSITION:

The Board of Emergency Services Commissioners, who shall be appointed by the Commissioners Court, shall be the governing body of the district. They shall serve for a term of two years and until their successors are appointed and qualified.

### CREATION AND AUTHORITY:

Created and operated under the provision of Chapter 775 of the Texas Health and Safety Code. This board was created by petition, called election and voter approved in May, 2010.

**MEETS:** Monthly on Mondays at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall, 203 East Main Street, Bishop, Texas, 78343. **TERMS:** Two-year staggered terms ending on December 31. Two board positions are effective January 1 of even-numbered years and three board positions are effective January 1 of odd-numbered years.
