

Project 9046 2013 Park Habitat Project

Billing this period included Professional, Engineering, Environmental, and Drafting services from November 15, 2013 through December 22, 2013. Work involved continued coordination with Nueces County Coastal Parks and evaluating a revised scope of work to avoid the costs and impacts to native grasses of a design approach involving filling, and instead pursue an approach involving individual planting of the introduced vegetation "root balls" amongst the native grasses. Work also involved assessing desired vegetation, coordination with vegetation and bird ecological experts, and design of the less intrusive planting approach. The originally planned planting/irrigation design to involve the construction and fill of cells would no longer be pursued.

Continued coordination with local nursery owner (James Gill) continued regarding the timing of planting, vegetation types, and a planting and irrigation scope of work. Draft designs were finalized and a preliminary set of construction drawings was completed. Proposals regarding the planting plan and the irrigation plan/components of the base bid package were evaluated.
