Dear Judge Neal:

On behalf of the American Red Cross and all the people we serve in Nueces County, thank you for your support in the form of the \$700 grant for fiscal year 2013-2014 which ended September 30, 2014.

Our fiscal year runs from July 1 – June 30, hence our report is reflective of that time period. I hope this in no way creates a problem for you.

During that time period from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014, our chapter and its volunteers responded to more than 141 disaster assistance requests and more than half of those occurred in Nueces County. Over 513 residents of our chapter were victims of those disasters and received direct assistance from the Red Cross as well as referrals to other agencies to ensure our clients had opportunities for assistance with their long-term recovery. We also provided assistance to over 299 of our service men and women and reached close to 10,000 people through our health and safety course offerings

We spend more than \$77,063 in our chapter for the support of disaster victims, including those in Nueces County. We appreciate the support we received from your office. More than 30% of our clients had annual family incomes of less than \$20,000, one-third were younger than 18 years of age, over half were women and 46% were of Latino descent. Close to 80% did not have insurance and almost the same percentage had no emergency plan.

Again, I would like to thank you and the Commissioners Court for your annual support of the American Red Cross. With your gift we are able to extend a helping hand today and provide hope for tomorrow to the citizens of Nueces County.
