
On behalf of the LEAD First Program and Superior Health Plan, I would like to give a report on the 8th Annual LEAD First Back to School Education and Diabetes Fair. The event was held on Saturday, August 16th, 2014 from 10:00 a.m. till 2:00 p.m., at Miller High School. We would like to thank the Commissioners for their support and efforts to educate and promote healthy life styles for persons living with Diabetes. There were over 4,200 participants for the event. We gave away free 300 immunizations, 2,420 vision testing, 2,000 hearing testing 2,200 Diabetes screening and testing and 310 physicals. The \$3,000 received from Nueces County Commissioners was for free shots, Diabetes screening, food, printing, facilities cost, and free Physicals. Thanks County Commissioners again, for your support, to help meet these great needs throughout our city and surrounding communities.

The LEAD First Back to School Education and Diabetes Fair is a community event designed to improve all aspects of the quality of life in the City of Corpus Christi including health care, community policing and economic development. The Fair include Health screening, Diabetes screening, diabetes education and information on healthy living, **entertainment, games, refreshments and information booths** for all community residents. There were numerous organizations present to let the community know about services and upcoming events that they are planning and gave their staff a chance to meet the local residents and join in the community celebration. The LEAD First and Superior Health Plan Back to School Education and Diabetes Fair hosted 4 coordination meetings on July 24th, August 6th and August 13th at 1:30 p.m. These meetings were held at Solomon Coles High School in our Outreach Office, Rm. 101 @ 924 Winnebago Street. The final meeting was held on Friday, August 15th, 2014 at 10:30am @ Miller High School in the GYM. This meeting consisted of setting up and packing backpacks, and extra volunteers showed up to participate.
