
Thank you for your letter, dated July 13, 2016, in which you outlined the actions taken by the County thus far and requested an extension of time to ensure the authorization of additional funds with which to complete the actions required under the Settlement Agreement.

Given the work and money the County has invested in making County programs, services, activities and facilities accessible to persons with disabilities, the Department is amenable to extending the term of the agreement for five years from the first day of the County's next fiscal year, or October 1, 2016. That would extend the agreement until September 30, 2021.

This extension is conditioned upon the County providing us with a revised schedule of deadlines for the work that remains to be completed. This schedule is subject to the approval of the Department. Please have Tyner Little forward a revised schedule to me at his earliest convenience.

We look forward to continuing to work with the County as it meets its obligations under the Settlement Agreement.
